Dear Suki,

Early summer of 2015 the exhibition "**Hybrids**" shall be opened at gallery Helder in The Hague, Netherlands. There will be several participants originating from different cultural backgrounds. On earlier occasions we already informed you. The exact period is planned to be **from 6th June until 5th July 2015**. In this letter we are glad to confirm your presence in this group exhibition.

The theme is about how art is influenced by the different cultural backgrounds of the artists. Therefore its title: "Hybrids". As time, religion, politics, society, media, globalization, immigration etc. vary in the world, does this also change our ideas about art? And how do we experience art from these different backgrounds? And does it change the meaning of art?

Each of the artists is expected to deliver one or a few art-works for the exhibition. There is neither a fee demanded for the artists' participation, nor will there be any contribution from the gallery.

The joint presentation and interaction of the many different disciplines from the East and West of the globe may well contribute to new experiences in the arts.

The opening show shall take place on Saturday 6th June 2015. Every artist is asked to be present. During the exhibition period, on selected weekend days, we will make a dedicated program to each one of the artists, so as to better understand about his/her work and profession. Think here e.g. of artist talk, performance etc. This program shall be developed together with the artist him/herself.
